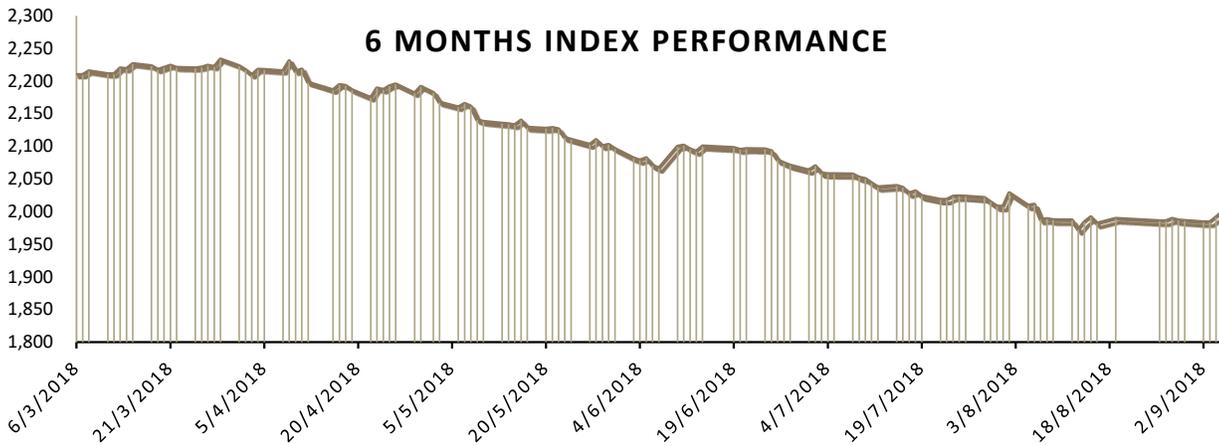

### Duterte departs Jordan after signing several memoranda

Philippine President Rodrigo Duterte left Amman on Friday after conducting a three-day state visit. The president was seen off by Social Development Minister Hala Lattouf, who was the head of the mission of honour accompanying the guest that comprised several civil and military officials, the Jordan News Agency, Petra, reported. His Majesty King Abdullah met with Duterte on Thursday over means to enhance bilateral relations and the latest regional developments. Duterte's visit also included signing several memoranda of understanding aimed at developing cooperation between Amman and Manila.

### Tuesday an official holiday — PM

Prime Minister Omar Razzaz announced that Tuesday will be an official holiday, halting the work of ministries, official departments, institutions and public bodies on the occasion of the Hijri New Year, the Jordan News Agency, Petra, reported.

### Germany to continue its political, financial support to UNRWA'

Germany will continue to provide UNRWA with political and financial support, said Bärbel Kofler, the federal government commissioner for human rights policy and humanitarian aid. In a German embassy statement sent to The Jordan Times, Kofler described the US' decision to withdraw funding for UNRAW as threatening "additional destabilisation in an already volatile region — Jordan alone has 2.3 million Palestinian Refugees". Kofler's remarks came during a meeting with the Foreign Ministry's senior officials in which she pledged that Berlin would continue assisting Jordan given its humanitarian support to Syrian refugees.
